Peacham Pond Association Road Committee Prioritization Matrix Development

In-scope Peacham Pond roads represent three of the 65 miles the Town of Peacham is responsible for maintaining... with only four people. As such, specific actions requested by the Road Committee will take time to complete. To insure requested actions yielding the greatest return are addressed first, a Prioritization Matrix by Improvement Category was developed. The three improvement categories include: drainage, trees/power lines, and boulders/rocks.

Prioritization Matrix by Improvement Category

Category	Priority	Prioritization	Condition	Suggested Action
Drainage	1	Roadway undermined and/or erosion at outlet	- Culvert rusted out, crushed or insufficient in length	- Town repairs or replaces
	2	Restricted water flow	- Clogged with dirt and debris - Ditch filled or needs reshaping - Standing water	- Town cleans out culvert - Town reshapes ditch feeding culvert
	3	Acceptable drainage surface condition	- Clear or reasonably clear pathway - No standing water	- Monitor
Trees and Power Lines	1	Immediate threat to power lines or roadway	- Dead trees - Close proximity to power lines or roadway - Evidence of being hit by plow or grader	- Town or GMP removes trees
	2	Future threat to power lines or roadway	- Dying or leaning trees - New trees or brush growing under power lines or near roadway	- Town or GMP removes trees - Town cuts brush along roadway
	3	Acceptable roadside condition	- No trimming or cutting necessary	- Monitor
Boulders and Rocks	1	Immediate obstacle/restriction to grading or plowing equipment	- Currently protruding from road surface - Close proximity to roadway - Evidence of being hit by grader or plows	- Town removes or pushes aside such boulders & rocks
	2	Future restriction to grading or plowing equipment	- Previously identified boulders & rocks not removed or pushed aside - Boulders still within right of way although not an immediate restriction	- Town removes or pushes aside such boulders & rocks - Monitor
