

## **Road Committee Communication #6**

### **Peacham Pond Association Road Committee – Couple of updates**

We reported in our last communication that a tree near the Steven's camp on Onion Point Road was pushed over by strong winds and was resting on a power line. Green Mountain Power (GMP) was advised. They quickly dispatched a crew to remove the tree.

Additionally, GMP performed an off-cycle assessment of electrical lines on Class 3 roads around Peacham Pond. GMP identified numerous tree hazards on the Onion Point Road side of the pond. The Peacham Pond Road side of the pond was determined to be in good condition. GMP decided to trim or remove identified tree hazards. Subsequently, the Town Highway Department was contacted to finish the job. They cut down remaining "topped off" trees and shred all branches and logs with their wood chipper.
